[Deferrals Submitted to Congress Pursuant to Impoundment Control Act]

Speaker of the House
President of the Senate



We were furnished copies of deferrals which the President submitted to the Congress on April 26, 1976, in his 14th special message for fiscal year 1976 pursuant to the Impoundment Control Act of 1974. The special message transmits two revised deferrals. The President estimates that the impoundments will have no effect on fiscal year 1976 outlays.

The Impoundment Control Act requires us to review each message and report promptly to the House and Senate as to the facts surrounding each action, including the probable effect thereof and, in the case of deferrals, to render a judgment as to whether the action is in accordance with existing legal authority. We are also required to notify the Congress if supplementary information revising earlier messages necessitates changes in the original reports submitted by GAO.


