GUIDELINES FOR CLASSIFYING
MANPOWER AND WELFARE DIVISION REPORTS
BY
GOVERNMENTAL FUNCTIONS, SUBFUNCTIONS, AND
PROGRAMS

1. The end product will be a yearly list, copies of which will be distributed to Mr. Ahart, Mr. Fenton, and anyone else having use for such a list.
2. Reports to be classified will include those submitted to the Congress, to its committees, or to Members of Congress.
3. The functional classifications to be used are primarily those used in the Federal Budget. See page 73 of the 1973 Budget.
4. Additional functional classifications will have to be devised to classify reports on activities involving two or more budget functions. Examples are (1) reports on reviews of activities of Community Action Agencies, and (2) reports on reviews of the award or administration of grants or contracts.
5. No report is to be classified under more than one functional heading.
6. Subfunctional and sub-subfunctional classifications are to be used when applicable. These are shown on pages 131, 144, 153, and 162 of the 1973 Budget.
7. The pages following pages 131, 144, 153, and 162 are very helpful in determining which subfunctional or sub-subfunctional classification a program or activity falls under.
8. The program title should be shown, where applicable.
9. The basic legislation should be shown in cases where the information might be useful.
10. The name of the department and bureau, or other subdivision or agency should be shown.
11. The title of the report, the B-number, and the date should be shown.
12. Cards should be prepared each month showing the pertinent information for each report released during the month.
13. Each month's cards should be merged with the cards for the preceding months.
14. The list should be typed ^{quarterly} from the cards.
15. The format to be used is illustrated on the attached list, which covers the first 4 months of the 1973 fiscal year.
